



NTG Contraindications:

- Hypotension
- Right ventricular infarction
- Severe aortic stenosis
- Phosphodiesterase inhibitors within previous 24 hours

High-Risk

Administer:

- High Intensity Statin (Atorvastatin 80 mg PO once)
- Anticoagulation (UFH or LMWH)

Consider:

- If CP remains, begin NTG infusion starting at 10 mcg/min (Contraindications)
- B-blockers - Metoprolol 50mg po once (Contraindications)
- One of the following -
 - Clopidogrel 300mg po once OR
 - Ticagrelor 180mg po once

Beta-b locker Contraindications:

- CHF signs/symptoms
- Evidence of low-cardiac output
- Risk of cardiogenic shock
- 2nd/3rd degree AV block
- Asthma/Reactive Airway Disease

What constitutes a negative cardiac test:

- Any stress test within one year that is adequate and negative
- CCTA within 2 years without plaque or stenosis
- LHC within 2 years that is negative or with non-obstructive (<50%) CAD
