
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## Inclusion Criteria:

- · Musculoskeletal or soft tissue trauma/pain
- Chronic pain (current, history of, or chart documentation of)
- Opioid tolerance or dependence (current, history of, or chart documentation of)
- · Sickle cell vaso-occlusive pain crisis
- Burns
- · Neuropathic pain
- · Physician discretion

## **Exclusion Criteria:**

- · Pregnant or breastfeeding women
- Known or suspected allergy to ketamine
- · Active chest pain, respiratory distress, or acute heart failure
- · Advanced liver disease or cirrhosis
- Patients < 18 yo</li>
- Active psychosis or mental health disturbance, hallucinogenic state or toxic exposure
- · Patients enrolled in current or ongoing research
- study that precludes participation (e.g. Sickle Cell)

## **Cautions and Warings:**

Ketamine should never be given in the following situations:

- Severe systemic hypertension (>180/110) or uncontrolled tachycardia
- Known or suspected traumatic brain injury
- · Cardiac arrhythmia
- · Ischemic heart disease or heart failure
- Elderly patients > 75 yo

## All Adverse Effects:

Most to Least Commonly Reported:

- Psychomimetic: Dizziness, Dysphoria, Agitation, Anxiety, Dream State, Hallucinations
- Nausea and/or Abdominal Pain
- · Sedation / Somnolence
- Sialorrhea
- Tachycardia, Hypertension, Hypoxia (Transient)
