

513-584-8282 WHEN SHOULD THE STROKE TEAM BE ACTIVATED?

- 1. Please call for
 - ALL patients with <u>ongoing</u> stroke symptoms presenting within 24 hours of symptom onset (<24 hours from "Last Known Well" (LKW))
 - Additionally, if there is a decline in neuro status, new headache, nausea, or vomiting after initial treatment by UC Stroke Team (posttreatment)
- 2. Do a quick history and exam including:
 - When was the patient last seen normal?
 - What are the key neurological deficits?
 - What are the vital signs?
 - What is the age of the patient?
 - Is the patient on a blood thinner such as warfarin/direct oral anticoagulant/heparin?
 - Has the patient had recent surgery?
 - What is the patient's fingerstick blood glucose?
- Please activate the team at (513) 584-8282 as soon as you have a quick (even if incomplete) history/exam for a stroke case in order to avoid potential delays in treatment.
- 4. Call us **before** the CT/CTA or any lab results return (to allow time for on call stroke physician to travel or log on to telemedicine video).
- 5. Please note that 513-584-8282 is a priority phone line for the UC Stroke Team that is answered by the UC Page Operator.
